COVID-19 Update

Dear Parents/Caregivers

As you are no doubt aware, the NSW Premier, Gladys Berejiklian, indicated this morning that the current lockdown will continue for a further week until Friday, July 16.

As a consequence, for the first week of Term 3, students will be learning from home.

During this week the school will remain open for students and families who need it. However, parents are encouraged to keep their children at home. There will only be minimal staff supervision and the school will provide one unit of work for students, whether they are learning from home or in the classroom. Canteen facilities will not be available for any student in attendance.

For those on site, all staff and students from Year 7 upwards will be required to wear masks. This is consistent with current requirements for masks to be worn in office and workplace settings and on transport services across Greater Sydney.

Parents and caregivers are not to enter school grounds unless they have an appointment. Any student displaying flu like symptoms will be sent home and is not to return until a negative COVID-19 result is received, and they are symptom free.

Year 12 students who are completing a practical subject for their HSC may need to attend school for exam preparation or assessment tasks. Teachers will communicate directly with students about what is required via CANVAS once the Department of Education has clarified what is permissible.
